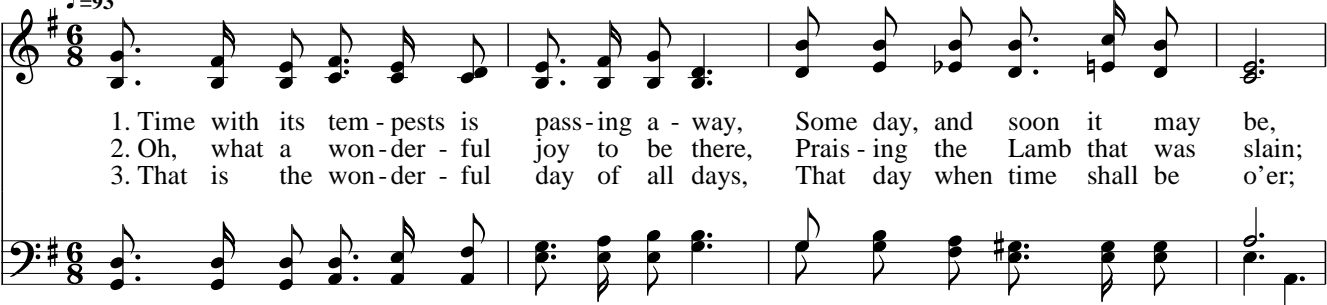

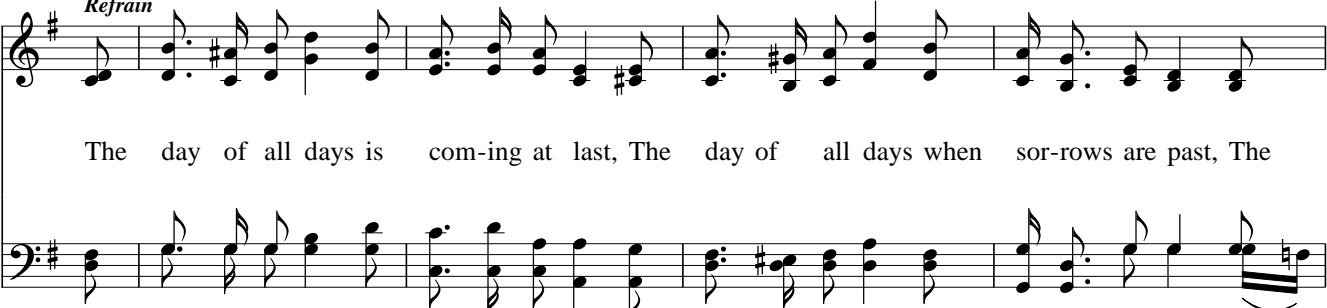


1. Time with its tem - pests is pass - ing a - way, Some day, and soon it may be,
