



Once I Thought I Walked with Jesus




1. Once I thought I walked with Je - sus, Yet such change-ful feel - ings had,

4. Bless-èd Sav - ior, Thou dost keep me By Thy power from day to day,




Some-times trust - ing, some-times doubt - ing, Some-times joy - ful, some-times sad.
