


Where Are Thy Sins?




1. Where are thy sins, O brother, where? Child of sor - row and des-pair,

4. Yield now, O yield! my brother dear, Je - sus speaks sweet words of cheer;




Dost thou still thy bur - dens bear? O bring them all to Je - sus.
