




1. Some-one will climb life's rug - ged hills; Some-one God's pur - pose will ful - fill;

3. Some-one will guide the lit - tle feet; Some-one the aged with kind - ness greet;




Some-one will ut - ter wis - dom's code; Some-one will soft - en sor - row's road.
