


# Gift So Great





4. Lord, I come, come to Thee, bring - ing all my sin, Thou a - lone can a - tone, wash me white with - in;




Hark - en, soul, hear Him call, o - pen wide the door, Taste and see love so free, yours for - ev - er - more;
